<p>Grow Food Feed People (GFFP): supporting food banks</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Start 18 flats of vegetables (575 plants) to be clients of six food pantries
<p>The GrowHaus: Globeville, Elyria-Swansea neighborhoods</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Materials to build backyard garden plots (due to existing soil is polluted).
<p>Juanita Nolasco Garden Club: Apt. complex, 188 units broad range of ethnicities</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Seed, Hoses and attachments, tools for differently -abled gardeners
<p>Sanctuary Garden Club (DUG): 100+ refugees and their children, local seniors</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tools to support the doubling the size of the garden this past fall
<p>West Colfax Community Urban Garden (DUG): broad cross-section of the West Colfax community</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Variety of garden tools to replace very old tools in very bad shape.
